Before Arrival

Before you get to the Hill

- Make sure you have
 - Gov't Photo ID for the Adult leaders
 - CD or flash drive with a picture and name of each participant
 - Vehicle registrations for equipment vehicles
 - Proof of insurance
 - If your state has <u>State Inspections Stickers</u> make sure it is current.
- Keep your Scouts and Leaders hydrated (everyone should have 1 liter of water on the bus during travel before arriving)

Check - In Procedures

Enter in the Assigned Gate

- Make sure you have
 - Gov't Photo ID
 - Vehicle registration
 - Proof of insurance
 - Jamboree Placard in front window of Bus containing the Scoutmaster with the <u>Council</u> <u>Number written</u> on it
- At that Point a SubCamp Commissioner will join your Troop

Check - In Procedures

- Your Troop will go directly to the Subcamp and stow the equipment
- The Scoutmaster will proceed to the medical facility to turn in their roster. (Bring with him the following persons)
 - contingent members whose medical status is not approved
 - Adults whose YPT dates are not within the date range,
 - Any contingent member that has been ill within the last 24 hours
 - Your Troops Health Records

Stoves must be checked by a Commissioner or Safety Officer




Connection to the Outside World
