Arrival Information:

Make sure everyone has a picture ID and your paper work is available for both you and your equipment vehicle.

For Sale:

We will have for sale, 4 sets of two-way radios. These radios are Motorola Talkabout, model T5720, with a 5-mile range. They are 22 channels FRS/GMRS, each with 38 "quiet" codes. They are weather resistant and have ni-cad re-chargeable batteries with a charger and belt clips. Used 10 days by the Commissioner staff. The radios retail for \$59.99 and we will sell them to you for a great deal of \$40.00 per set. Please let me know if you are interested.

Worth mentioning again (and again and again):

Drink plenty of water on your trip to the Jamboree and during the Jamboree.

All Scouts and leaders should have summer weight sleeping bags.

Provide large plastic bags to store the sleeping bags in during the day to keep them dry.

Make sure each Scout checks every day for ticks and stay out of the wooded areas.
